Bristol Township Names Public Works Director

Township Manager Bill McCauley today announced that Ray Hopkins, a long-time Crew Leader with the Township, has been named Director of Public Works.

“Ray Hopkins earned this promotion based on his 47 years of loyal and faithful service to Bristol Township and the Department will continue to improve with his leadership,” McCauley said. “Ray started working full-time in Public Works in 1971 after three years as a summer employee while he was in high school,” he noted.

According to McCauley, Hopkins was recommended for the job by the Acting Public Works Director, Jack Snyder. “Jack came to me and said that he was happy to serve the Township in his acting capacity, but I had someone in-house who was capable of doing the job, already working in the Department,” he said. McCauley said that he spoke to Hopkins shortly after his conversation with the Acting Public Works Director. “When somebody with Jack Snyder’s experience in public works suggests someone to take their place, you listen to them,” he stated.

“The Township was extremely fortunate to find someone with Ray’s background, training and experience,” McCauley said. “I had assumed that he was more interested in retirement than a promotion, but I am glad that he accepted,” he said. McCauley said that it was very rewarding to be able to recognize and promote a long-time Township employee to the post.

Mr. Hopkins began working as the Director of Public Works on July 9, 2018. He will earn \$75,000 a year in his new position.
