Township Manager Bill McCauley announced today that Bristol Township will host the annual Holiday Parade in the Levittown section of Bristol Township on Saturday, November 18. “Everyone in the Bristol community knows that the holiday season does not begin until the Township has its annual parade, and it is a great family event to get you in the spirit of the season,” said McCauley.

Spectators should begin to assemble at 11:00 am as the parade kicks off promptly at 12:00 pm. But this year, the route is the reverse of what it traditionally has been, according to McCauley. Participants will begin at Ben Franklin School (6403 Millcreek Road) and conclude at Brookwood Elementary School (2200 Haines Road).

The parade will feature dozens of popular participants and groups, including Bristol Township’s Council members, Congressman Brian Fitzpatrick, fire companies and emergency responders, the Philadelphia Eagles Pep Band, the Harry S. Truman Marching Band, the Bristol Township Baton Twirlers, antique car clubs, and other local organizations. Of course, Santa Claus will be in attendance bringing up the rear, closing the parade with a bang, and officially opening the holiday season.

Santa’s Elves will be collecting letters to Santa along the parade route. Letters to Santa collected with a return address will receive a special return note from Santa himself.
