### **Bristol Township Celebrates the Holidays with the 16th Annual Holiday Parade on Nov. 19**

On Saturday, November 19, Bristol Township will host the annual Holiday Parade in the Levittown section of Bristol Township. Spectators should begin to assemble at 11:00am and the parade kicks off at 12:00 p.m. The parade starts at Brookwood Elementary School (2200 Haines Road) and concludes at Ben Franklin School (6403 Mill Creek Road).

The parade will feature dozens of popular groups, including Bristol Township's fire companies and emergency responders, Philadelphia Eagles pep band and the Harry S. Truman marching band. Several other groups such as the Friends of Bolton Mansion will be participating in the parade for the first time. Santa's Elves will also be collecting letters to Santa Claus along the parade route.

Bristol's Manager, Bill McCauley said "Bristol Township has much to be thankful for and so many reasons to celebrate during the holiday parade and throughout the holiday season. Money Magazine recently named the Levittown section of Bristol Township as the '41st Best Place to Live in America' and was the only community in Pennsylvania to make the list," he said.
